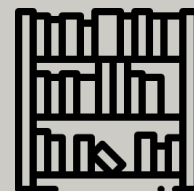
The library had **2,236** open hours!

Print materials totaled **19,476**



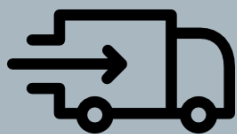
Physical videos totaled **3,296**

In 2024, the library's service area population was 2,740. The total funds invested in the library from local sources was \$387,148. Funding from the state was \$28,279 and federal funding was \$0.
